Types of Targets:	10m Olympic / 3P Precision:		Electronic targets, 3P Friday only	
	10m Sporter, 3P Springer and 3P Sporter:		Multi Diagram paper targets, Friday and Saturday	
Number of shots / durations:	As per latest SAARA Rules and Regulations

Medical Condition:	If you suffer from any medical condition or injury prohibiting you to participate in any position of an event, the form "Request to Substitute a Position", Appendix N in the SAARA Rules and Regulations, must be completed and submitted (complete with the necessary supporting documentation) together with your entry form.			
Medication:	If a shooter suffers from a documented medical condition requiring the use of a Prohibited Substance or a Prohibited Method, he/she must be in possession of an approved Drug Free Sport Therapeutic Use Exemption ("TUE").			

Clarification of rules.

Please note the following clarification regarding the ISSF and SAARA rules. It has been pointed out that we are not applying the rules consistently. Please adhere to these rules to ensure that we can start the relays on time.

ISSF Rules

6.11.1.1 c) Athletes may not place their guns and equipment on their firing points until the Chief Range Officer has called the athletes to the line.

SAARA Rules

10.3.2 - When shooting on multi-diagram targets: The athlete is responsible for securely applying the targets in the correct sequence and for the correct stage to the backing boards provided. All targets must be placed on the targets stands before the command "Call to the line" is given
